INTRODUCTION

Sisters, in this moment we are invited to make ourselves aware of the presence of God in us.

In Letter 1, Fr. Francisco Palau exhorts: "Enter in the temple of your soul; remain there in silence and listen to the voice of God... who speaks to you always from the bottom of your heart".

(Letter 13,5). "All of you sisters shall be united with one another in God, with sacred bonds of love" (Leg. I,21).

- 2. **I believe** that you are God and neighbor.
- 3. **I believe** That all human form one Body under Christ, its Head.
- 4. **I believe** that where there is Christ, there is Church... one only kingdom, one only family, one body united with bonds stronger than those of material body by God. He himself, the Holy Spirit who does what a soul does in an individual.
- 5. **I believe** that this body is called the Church.
- 6. **I believe** that the Church is an immense beauty... the only object of love of human heart.
- 7. **I believe** that you, oh Church, have Spirit and live, understand and love, talk, hear and see.
- 8. **I believe** that you can respond with love to those who love you.
- 9. **I believe** that in you love is the Holy Spirit, the Third Person of Trinity, who gives life, movement, virtue, grace and glory.
- 10. **I believe** that in you, for you and with you Triune God is at work and outside of you there is no salvation nor happiness.
